If you are a survivor, this **FREE** 5-week program is will help you regain self-confidence and empower you to manage your own life. Topics include:

- Education and job training
- Coaching on job-readiness and employment seeking skills
- Development of personal financial plans
- Credit reports/credit counseling
- Assistance with budgeting, debt-reduction, saving and investing
- Banking practices and account management
- Many incentives including bus passes and gift cards

Who is eligible?

Survivors of domestic violence, current or past participants of Operation Care domestic violence programs. Dates and times will be determined based upon participant schedules. Program will begin in June.
